Bankruptcy Court Issues Order Approving Interim Financing For Abengoa Bioenergy

Chesterfield, MO, March 2, 2016 – The St. Louis bankruptcy court today issued an order approving \$7 million of interim financing for the six Abengoa Bioenergy companies which recently filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. The order was issued after two recently filed involuntary bankruptcy actions in Kansas and Nebraska were transferred to the US Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Missouri for consolidated administration in St. Louis at Abengoa’s request. In First Day hearings held this morning, the Court granted several motions filed by Abengoa Bioenergy requesting approval of this loan and other typical relief in order to fund ongoing payroll and other ordinary course operational expenses necessary to keep the company in business and allow it to maintain and protect the companies’ assets.

Antonio Vallespir, President and Chief Executive Officer of Abengoa Bioenergy, said, “We are very pleased that the Court approved this financing and the other motions and requests that we have made in order to protect and maximize the value of the assets for all stakeholders. These requests were made in order to stabilize the involved companies and allow them to operate pending further hearings on plans to restart one or both of Abengoa’s Nebraska ethanol plants, which were recently idled.”
