Pursuant to Sections 105, 330, and 331 of Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code, (the “Bankruptcy Code”), Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”), Rule 2016-1 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Ohio (the “Local Bankruptcy Rules”), the *Order Authorizing Retention and Employment of Sitrick And Company, Inc. as Corporate Communications Consultant to the Debtors Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date* [Docket No. 500] (the “Retention Order”), the *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals*, dated April 26, 2018 [Docket No. 427] (the “Interim Compensation Order”), the Guidelines for Compensation and Expense Reimbursement of Professionals (the “Local Guidelines”), and the Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective as of November 1, 2013 (the “U.S. Trustee Guidelines”), Sitrick And Company, Inc. (“Sitrick”), corporate communications consultants for the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the “Debtors”), hereby files this monthly fee statement (the “Monthly Fee Statement”) for the period of February 25, 2019 through March 31, 2019 (the “Fee Period”).² Specifically, Sitrick seeks payment in the amount of \$82,836.80 which is equal to 80% of \$103,546.00, the total amount of compensation sought for actual and necessary services rendered to the Debtors during the Fee Period, and reimbursement in the amount of \$9,590.71 for actual and necessary costs and expenses incurred by Sitrick in connection with such services during the Fee Period.
