Order Granting Joint Motion to Transfer Case to Another District

At South Bend, Indiana, on January 21, 2020.

Now before the Court is the Joint Motion of (I) Mark T. Iammartino, Chapter 11 Trustee; (II) Kelly M. Hagan, Chapter 11 Trustee; (III) The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Najeeb Ahmed Khan; and (IV) The Official Unsecured Creditors Committee of Interlogic Outsourcing, Inc., for Transfer of Venue Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408, 1412 and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1014 (Doc 614). The court has determined that the movants have sent proper notice to all interested parties. No objections to the Motion have been filed. The court finds that the Motion is well-taken and the court now GRANTS the Motion.

The court now transfers the above-captioned cases, including all pending motions, applications, contested matters, and adversary proceedings associated with these cases, to the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Michigan. This court now removes from its calendar all scheduled hearings in these cases and all associated adversary proceedings. For clarity of the record in each adversary proceeding the court will enter separate orders to transfer those proceedings to the Western District.

As of the date of this order, pending are the following adversary proceedings in which, due to their transfer, this court will take no further action:

- 19-3029, Interlogic Outsourcing, Inc., et al v. Jones Law Office, LLC, et al.
- 19-3032, Jones Law Office, LLC, et al v. Interlogic Outsourcing, Inc., et al.
- 19-3037, Universal Credit Services, Inc. v. Interlogic Outsourcing, Inc., Najeeb Khan, KeyBank National Association, and Does 1-10.

As of the date of this order, pending in the Interlogic Outsourcing bankruptcy are the following matters, in which the court will take no further action due to their transfer, and it leaves the resolution of these matters to the court in the Western District.

- Doc 482, Motion of Wells Fargo Bank, NA for Entry of an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d) Authorizing (I) Relief from the Automatic Stay to Enforce Its Rights Against Bank Accounts and a Continued Freeze on the Accounts, or (II) Granting Adequate Protection.

- Doc 673, First Application of Hammerschmidt, Amaral & Jonas for Interim Allowance and Payment of Professional Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period of August 23, 2019, through December 19, 2019.
