PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to the Reclassified Employee Objections and the *Order (I) Approving Omnibus Claims Objections Procedures and (II) Authorizing the Debtors to File Substantive Omnibus Objections to Claims Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3007(c), (d)* [Docket No. 1842], a hearing on the Reclassified Employee Objections was set for June 16, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. (prevailing Central Time).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the hearing on the Reclassified Employee Objections previously set for June 16, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. (prevailing Central Time) has been rescheduled for **July 13, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time)** before David R. Jones, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge, in Courtroom 400 of the United States Bankruptcy Court, 515 Rusk Street, Houston, TX 77002.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that audio communication will be by use of the Court's dial-in facility. You may access the facility at (832) 917-1510. You will be responsible for your own long distance charges. Once connected, you will be asked to enter the conference room number. Judge Jones' conference room number is 205691.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that you may view video via GoToMeeting. To use GoToMeeting, the Court recommends that you download the free GoToMeeting application. To connect, you should enter the meeting code "JudgeJones" in the GoToMeeting app or click the link on Judge Jones' home page on the Southern District of Texas website. Once connected, click the settings icon in the upper right corner and enter your name under the personal information setting.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that appearances must be made electronically in advance of the hearing. To make your electronic appearance, go to the Southern District of Texas website and select "Bankruptcy Court" from the top menu. Select "Judges' Procedures," then "View Home Page" for Judge Jones. Under "Electronic Appearance" select "Click here to submit Electronic Appearance". Select the case name, complete the required fields and click "Submit" to complete your appearance.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that if you object to the relief requested, you must either appear at the hearing or file a written response prior to the hearing. Otherwise, the Court may treat the pleading as unopposed and grant the relief requested.
