ORDER SUSTAINING DEBTORS' FIRST OMNIBUS (NON-SUBSTANTIVE) OBJECTION TO (INSUFFICIENT DOCUMENTATION) CLAIMS PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY CODE SECTION 502(b), BANKRUPTCY RULES 3001, 3003, AND 3007, AND LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 3007-1

Upon the objection (the "*Objection*")² of the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "*Debtors*"), pursuant to Bankruptcy Code 502(b), Bankruptcy Rules 3001, 3003, and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1, seeking entry of an order: (i) disallowing each of the Insufficient Documentation Claims identified on Exhibit 1, attached hereto; and (ii) authorizing the Claims Agent to expunge each of the Insufficient Documentation Claims from the Claims Register; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Objection and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the Amended Standing Order; and consideration of the Objection and the relief requested therein being a core proceeding in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and venue being proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Objection being

adequate and appropriate under the particular circumstances; and upon the record of all proceedings had before the Court; and the Court having found and determined that the relief sought in the Objection is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, and other parties in interest and that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. The Objection is sustained as set forth herein.
2. The Insufficient Documentation Claims set forth on the attached Exhibit 1 are hereby disallowed and expunged in their entirety.
3. The Claims Agent is authorized to modify the Claims Register to comport with the entry of this Order.
4. Notwithstanding the relief granted in this Order and any actions taken pursuant to such relief, nothing in this Order shall be deemed: (i) an admission as to the validity of any particular claim (including any Proof of Claim) against any Debtor; (ii) a waiver of the Debtors' rights to dispute any particular claim (including any Proof of Claim); (iii) a promise or requirement to pay any particular claim (including any Proof of Claim); (iv) an implication or admission that any particular claim (including any Proof of Claim) is of a type specified or defined in this Objection; or (v) a waiver or limitation of the Debtors' rights under the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules, Local Rules or any other applicable law.
5. Notwithstanding the possible applicability of Bankruptcy Rules 6004(h), 7062, 9014 or otherwise, the terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

6. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Order.

7. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation or interpretation of this Order.
