PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on **October 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. (Central Time)**, a hearing will be held before the Honorable Marvin Isgur in Courtroom 404, 515 Rusk Street, Houston, Texas, on the following matters:

1. Debtors’ Emergency Motion for Entry of an Order (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Pay Prepetition Wages, Salaries, Other Compensation, and Reimbursable Expenses and (B) Continue Employee Benefit Programs, and (II) Granting Related Relief (the “Wage Motion”) [Docket No. 8].
2. Debtors’ Emergency Motion for Entry of an Interim Order (I) Authorizing the Payment of Working Interest Costs, Joint Interest Billings, Production Sale Expenses, and 503(b)(9) Claims and (II) Confirming Administrative Priority of Outstanding Orders (the “JIB Motion”) [Docket No. 12].
3. Debtors’ Emergency Motion for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Continue to Operate Their Cash Management System, (B) Honor Certain Prepetition Obligations Related Thereto, (C) Maintain Existing Business Forms, (D) Perform Intercompany Transactions; and (II) Granting Related Relief (the “Cash Management Motion”) [Docket No. 13].
