ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard before the undersigned United States Bankruptcy Judge upon the Ex Parte Motion for Order Shortening Notice (the “Motion to Shorten Notice”) in respect of a hearing on (a) the Joint Motion of Debtors and Proposed Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants for an Order Appointing Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants and (b) the Joint Application of the Debtors and Proposed Official

Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants for an Order Appointing Lawrence Fitzpatrick as Legal Representative for Future Asbestos Claimants (the “Motions”), and the Court, having reviewed the pleadings and the Court’s file and for good cause shown it is hereby ORDERED:

- A. That the Motion to Shorten Notice is GRANTED;
