**NOTICE OF BAR DATE FOR FILING APPLICATIONS
FOR ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIMS**

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT on August 31, 2015, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Florida (the “Court”) entered an *Order Granting Motion of Debtors and Debtors in Possession to Fix Bar Date for Filing Applications Seeking Administrative Expenses and to Designate Form and Manner of Notice of Bar Date* (the “Order”) [ECF No. 491] fixing October 13, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. (Prevailing Eastern Time) as the deadline for asserting an administrative expense claim (each an “Administrative Expense Claim”) against Adinath Corp. (“Adinath”) and Simply Fashion Stores, Ltd. (“Simply Fashion”, and together with Adinath, collectively, the “Debtors”).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT any creditor or party in interest seeking allowance of an Administrative Expense Claim against the Debtors, other than Prime Clerk LLC, a professional who has been retained in the Debtors’ chapter 11 cases by the Debtors or the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, and Government Agencies (as defined in the Order) shall only be permitted to do so by filing a written application **SO THAT IT IS ACTUALLY RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE 5:00 P.M. (PREVAILING EASTERN TIME) on October 13, 2015** (the “Administrative Claims Bar Date”) by the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Florida (the “Clerk”) at the following address:²

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT all requests for allowance of Administrative Expense Claims must be submitted in a form and in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and the Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Florida.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT the failure to assert a request for allowance of an Administrative Expense Claim (i) in accordance with this Notice, and (ii) before the Administrative Expense Claims Bar Date, shall preclude and bar forever any such claimant from asserting an Administrative Expense Claim after the Administrative Expense Claims Bar Date set forth herein.
